Issue:

It has been the annual practice of the Governing Board to authorize institutional memberships on the recommendation of the District administration. Individual memberships may also be included provided they are for the good of the District and have Cabinet-level approval.

Plan:

Memberships are listed below with information describing the type and importance of the membership as well as the cost of each. Funds have been allocated for the majority of memberships in the budget of the Assistant Superintendent, Educational Services. Memberships for Western Association of Schools and Colleges and CIF dues are mandated while other memberships are considered to be essential to the effective management of the District.

Fiscal Impact:

Total cost of the above memberships for the 2015-2016 school year is \$2,885. The mandated membership costs are budgeted by Educational Services. Categorically funded programs and departments that are self-supporting will fund some of the remaining membership costs. General fund money will be used only with the approval of the corresponding department Cabinet-level member.
