a. Seven individuals will participate in the WASC (Western Association of Schools and Colleges) Accreditation Process as visiting committee members for Santana High School. While each of these individuals is a volunteer, the district is required to reimburse any costs associated with their travel expenses. Total costs not to exceed \$7,000. Fall 2014 through Spring 2015.	WASC \$7,000
b. Youth and Leaders Living Actively (YALLA) will provide soccer practices and lessons, nutrition instruction and fitness assessments during the summer session. July 13, through August 28, 2015.	RSIG \$6,000
c. A-B-CPR will provide CPR and First Aide training for coaches, walk-on coaches, and cheer advisors for the 2015-2016 school year. July 1, 2015, through June 30, 2016.	Lottery \$6,000
d. Conscious Teaching, LLC, will present the workshop "Conscious Classroom Management" during the 215-2016 school year. October 8, 2015.	BTSA \$3,800
e. Ernie Mendes (Mendes Training & Consulting, Inc.) will present "Differentiated Instruction for the Teenage Brain" and "Working With Challenging Students and Adults, Parts I & II" during the 2015-2016 school year. November 2, 2015, through June 30, 2016.	BTSA \$7,200
f. Rachel Kok will provide clinical supervision to GUHSD social workers/therapists/trainees as the facilitate individual/group counseling services to youth attending Granite Hills and Grossmont High Schools. August 21, 2015, through June 30, 2016.	Site Funds \$6,500
g. The Flippen Group (Capturing Kids' Hearts) will provide an intensive three-day professional development in the area of improving school culture and helping to begin the PBIS implementation for up to 50 people at El Cajon Valley High School. August 26 through 28, 2015.	Title I \$52,600
h. Boys to Men will provide direct mentoring groups/activities to youth attending the Grossmont Union High School District. June 30, 2015, through June 30, 2016.	There is no cost for this consultant

San Diego Youth Services (SDYS) will provide information regarding suicide prevention, and distribute school/community-wide information with a number to a crisis line, strategies to enlist teacher and parent participation seminars and classes. July 1, 2015, through June 30, 2016.	There is no cost for this consultant
