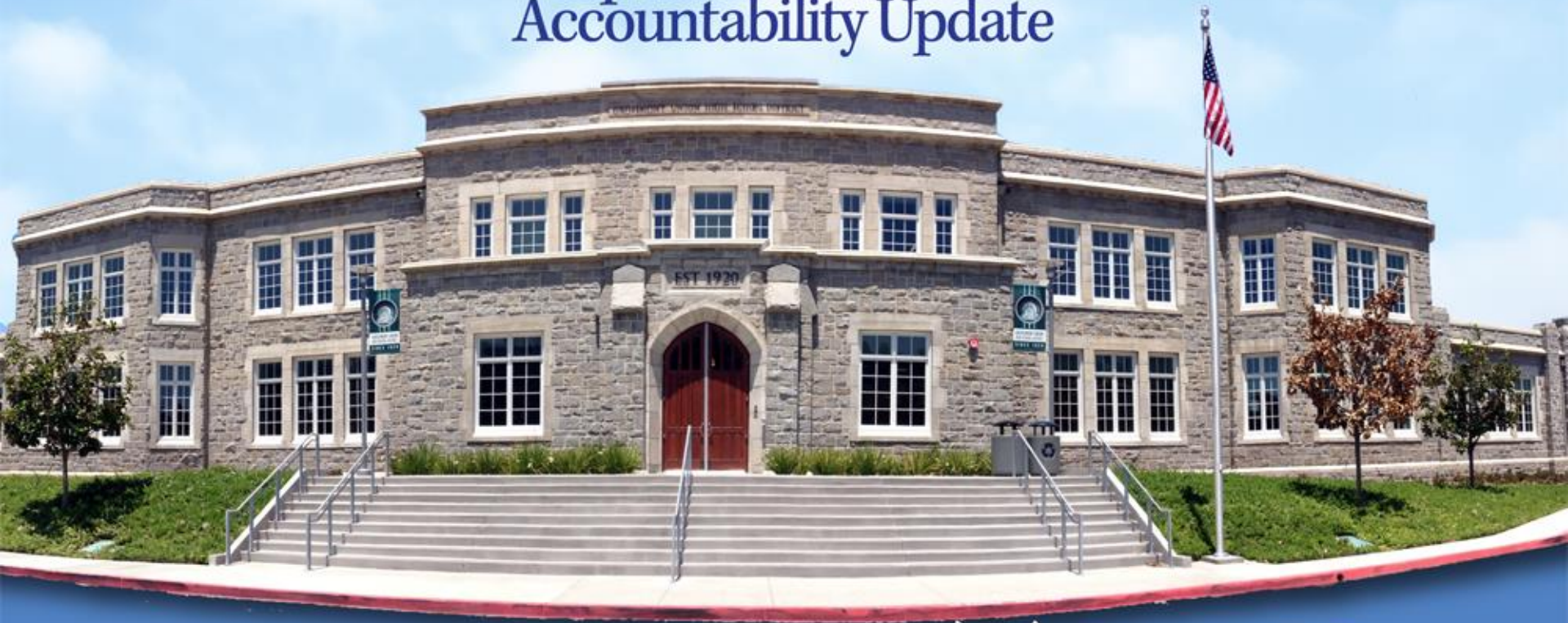

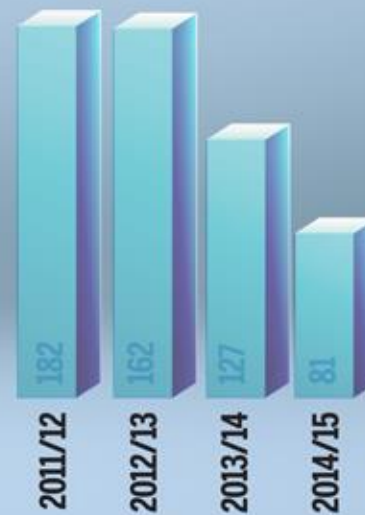


## Program of Interventions Decreases Number of Suspensions and Expulsions
